

- 3. TSAA has the right to refuse any work deemed unsuitable, i.e. nudes.
- 4. Maximum size shall not exceed **48 inches** in any dimension, including FRAME. (we will not hang anything larger)
- 5. Entries must remain for the entire show. (NO EX-CEPTIONS)
- 6. In the event of a sale the artist will donate 20% to the Cultural Center.
- 7. Payment of a \$10.00 entry fee will be collected at registration.

Only 2014 members are eligible for the show. You must have paid your dues before January 2014 and the November 2014 meeting to be eligible. No late entries accepted.

PLEASE REMEMBER to complete your registration forms **BEFORE** you come to register. There are three small forms on one sheet of paper. (See page 3) You will keep one and place one on the back of the artwork and TSAA keeps the third.

All art must be ready to hang. We cannot repair frames that are not secure. It is the artist's responsibility to have a secure frame and hanging wire.

Display locations are <u>final</u>. It is not possible to move art if the artist wants a different display location.

The rules of the show have been adopted after years of work. Please follow them and we will have a positive exhibit experience.


