Rotation of Art:

Every other month, on the 3rd Tuesday of the month @ 11 AM

Display will be nine (9) paintings with the frame minimum size 18" x 24" with a maximum width of 33".

Process:

Business cards are required of the artist(s) presenting and will be kept in the book at the gift shop.

Sign in at the Main Entrance Lobby Desk. You will be given a Yellow Visitor's Pass. (This gives you access to bring your Art up to the 2nd Floor.)

Purchase of Art:

FHNP will not take any commission in the sale of any art. Any interested party will contact the Gift Shop and they will give the interested party the business card of the Artist they requested.

All transactions will be between the artist and the purchaser.

The artist will call Rose, Yiota or Sue and inform her of the sale of the art and arrange for the art to be taken down. When they come to take down the painting they will be required to replace the item with another. NO artwork is to be removed by the purchaser, volunteers, or staff.

Removal of Art/Rotation:

At NO time will there be a blank place. Art is to be on the wall at all times.

It is important to keep up with the rotation.

If we have no one show up to put up more paintings then no one can take down what is already displayed.

Paint & Photo Brooker Creek Preserve is a cooperative event between the Friends of Brooker Creek and the Tarpon Springs Art Association. This plein air event will take place on Oct. 9 – 11, with a reception and awards on Sunday, Oct. 12 in the beautiful auditorium located in the Preserve. The work will stay up for the following week which corresponds with the Preserve's Wildflower Festival (10/18).
