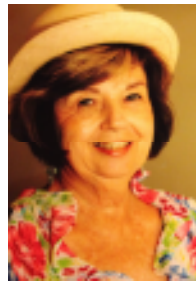

**The TSAA Plein Air Painters:**

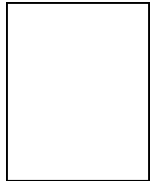
The Plein Air group will meet in Waterside Park in Dunedin at 9:30, Friday mornings during April. If you have questions call Jane Lawson at 934-6097.
