That is the service entrance, which is a small lane to the right before you get to the main parking lot. You will need to drop off your art/dish and then go around to the parking lot to park your car. There is no parking by the service door.

I know that the location could be inconvenient for some, but we are so fortunate to be able to hold the show this year, since we could not last year. Let me know if you want lunch.


