received a Yellow for his "Coming of the Storm" on metal.

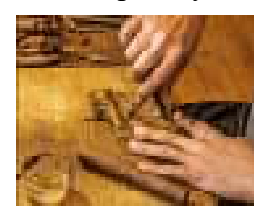

This tip is something you should approach regularly and be really tough and honest with your self. By knowing what you're not good at artistically and making a conscious effort to attack it (them, could be lots of things), will enable you to systematically grow. For instance, if you draw a lot of humans but avoid drawing feet because you know you're not that good at it, set aside time to draw lots of feet, over and over again until they look right (just be sure not to get a foot fetish). Draw and Draw Some More! Drawing things that you don't draw often or at all will increase your repertoire and will enable you to paint and illustrate more complex pictures.
