Friends of Brooker Creek Preserve, Inc, a non-profit support organization of Brooker Creek Preserve, is pleased to announce Plein Air 2023 Art Event and Exhibition. This annual program is designed to encourage the use of the 8,700-acre wilderness Preserve, managed by Pinellas County Land Management, as a nature inspiration for works of art.

All artists and photographers (amateurs to professionals) are invited to participate to show their talent and support for Brooker Creek by creating art inspired by the natural landscape of the Preserve. Participants, even those preregistered, check-in at the boardwalk entrance by the parking area on Friday, April 7 or Saturday, April 8 from 8 to 10 am to receive their information packet. All artwork must be created on the Preserve grounds during one of those two days to participate in the exhibition and judging of Brooker Creek Preserve Plein Air 2023.

All paperwork and completed artwork must be turned into the Friends Nature Store in the Education Building on either day of the event up until 4 PM. Photography (with pre-approved paperwork) may be turned in Sunday, April 9 between 10 AM and Noon at the BCP Auditorium Gallery.

Up to two presentation ready pieces may be submitted for the competition. Works may be framed (matting if desired) or canvas wrapped and must

have a wire on the back for hanging (with submission form with title, size, medium and sales price also attached).

Brooker Creek Preserve Plein Air 2023 Exhibition will be on view April 9 – April 23; hours are 9 AM - 3 PMSaturday and 11 AM -3 PM Sunday. The sale of artwork is encouraged and a donation of 10% from sales as a donation to the Friends of Brooker Creek Preserve, Inc. is requested.

All sold artwork is be picked up by the purchasers from the BCP Auditorium Gallery between 3–4 PM on Sunday, April 23. All unsold artworks are to removed at this time by the artists, or will be placed in the Friends Nature Store where they must be picked up Thursday through Sunday of the following week during store

Cost to participate is a \$20 non-refundable fee to Friends of Brooker Creek Preserve. We strongly encourage early registration to assure participation. Cash prizes for the juried show will be awarded for Best in Show (\$100), First (\$75), Second (\$50), Third (\$25), and Visitor's Choice (\$25) Awards. This year Ann Larsen, former director of the Leepa-Rattner Museum of Art, will be serving as the judge for Plein Air 2023: Brooker Creek Preserve.

Juried prizes will be awarded for Best in Show (\$100), First (\$75), Second (\$50) and Third (\$25), and Visitor's Choice (\$25) Awards.
- Completed art must be turned into the Friends Nature Store in the Exhibit Hall either day of the event up until 4 PM. Photography (with gre-approved paperwork) may be turned in Sunday, April 9 between 10 AM and noon to the Auditorium Gallery.
- My artwork will be on display in the Auditorium Gallery at Brooker Creek Preserve from April 9 through April 23 and will be offered for sale with the understanding that 10% of artwork sales will be donated to Friends
- Artwork, sold or unsold, must be removed from the premises following the Artists Reception between 4-5 PM on April 23.

Betty Stallard was awarded the Merit Award for her painting MACAW at the West Pasco Art Guild. This painting also sold at the Awards Ceremony.

Lora VanNoord will have 3 oil paintings in the new Stirling Art Studio exhibit on April 4 until April 30. None of them have been shown in an exhibit before. The reception will be open to the public April 14th, 5:30 pm.

Then, on April 17, she will join the new Oldsmar Library exhibit with 3 animal oil paintings.

Peggy McCardle recently published a book, "The Life and Art" of Frank Eugene Kowing, Jr., (Native American Artist By Frank E. Kowing Jr and Peggy McCardle). The book is the result of an agreedupon collaboration that then turned into McCardle's work in fulfillment of a promise that she would see the work through to publication after Kowing took his own life in 2016. It contains Kowing's biography and the essays that he sent McCardle as "writing assignments" she requested of him in the decades before his death (about artists who influenced his work and his own views of art). The book also contains color photos of more than 50 of Kowing's works, from 1969 to 2014 as well as photographs of a posthumous show, "Howl: The Art and Life of Frank Kowing" held at the Chahalu Museum and Cultural Center of the Confederated Tribes of the Grand Ronde in Oregon. The book is available on Amazon.com.
