Did you know? I didn't!

The Pinellas Public Library Cooperative has passes for free entry into select local museums and attractions (like parks) that you can check out for a week with your library card. Tarpon Springs Public Library, as a Cooperative member, participates in this amazing program.

You can check out a free pass with your library card, like a book. Your checked out pass will be due for return a week after you check it out. The pass will admit – at no cost - up to two adults and 3 children to the museum or attraction. The number of passes is limited, so planning ahead is essential. You may have to plan your visit based on when a returned pass becomes available again.

Some of the participating museums or attractions include the Leepa Ratner Museum, Museum of Fine Arts, Dunedin Fine Art Center Children's museum, the Sunken Gardens in St Pete, James Museum of Western and Wildlife Art, the Glazer Children's Museum, Imaginarium, and more.

TSAA has contracted with the Tarpon Art Guild Gallery for the month of November to exhibit on the Back Wall. This is a members only exhibit. November is a great month as many tourists and residents are shopping for presents (some for themselves!).

The artwork must be wired and ready to hang; watercolor, oil, acrylic, mixed media, collage, pen and ink, colored pencil charcoal and photography will be accepted.

There is no theme for this exhibit. Artwork must not have won a ribbon or award at a previous TSAA exhibit and should be done without consultation from others (such as workshop work).

TSAA has the right to refuse any work deemed unacceptable i.e. nudes, mating animals, etc.

Please submit for sale entries only. If the buyer wishes to take the artwork at the time of the sale, the artist will be given the opportunity to replace it. If the artist cannot or does not wish to replace it, members will be offered the opportunity to do so.

Artwork that has not been sold is to remain for the entire duration of the exhibit. Please do not plan to pick up your artwork sooner than the pick up date!

In the event of a sale, 25% of sales price will be donated to the Tarpon Art Guild Gallery so you might wish to price submissions accordingly.
