Oldsmar City Hall Exhibit January 21 - February 27, 2025

The Tarpon Springs Art Association has been invited to return to the Oldsmar City Hall for an exhibit from January 21, 2025 thru February 27, 2025, with a reception being held on January 28.

There will be no charge for TSAA members (in good standing...meaning dues for 2025 have been paid) to exhibit up to two works of art, there is no commission taken. Sales are between the artist and the buyer, and the Arts Coordinator of the City of Oldsmar, Joan Byrne, will put the buyer and the artist in contact with each other. All artwork entered must be for sale; no NFS, please!

In the event of a sale prior to the end of the exhibit, the buyer can take the art with them and the artist will have the opportunity to submit another piece of artwork. All artworks will need to be 2D, wired for hanging (no sawtooth, please) and no larger than 30 in. x 34 in. and no smaller than 8 in. x 10 in., frames included. The artist must have their name, phone number and/or email address posted on the back.

Register your artwork no later than January 16! The following information should be emailed to Trish Gregory Hartley at (<u>peg3400@gmail.com</u>) NO LATER THAN JANUARY 16, 2025: Artist name, title, medium, size, and price of artwork, artist email and artist phone number. This information needs to be given to the City of Oldsmar Art Coordinator In advance of the drop off date of January 21!

Clifton started to paint at an early age.
